Maple Leaf Tesselation

10" (10 1/2" finished)

Please use 100% cotton fabrics. PLEASE PREWASH THE FABRIC. Note: When making a Block of the Month, please read the instructions carefully, particularly regarding the fabric choices. The pictures may not always be representative of the fabric selection.

Fabrics: For the 2 main leaves, use fall colored prints. You can use a dark green print for one of them.

For the shadow leaves, use light to medium tan prints. Try not to get too dark. You will need 4 different prints.

Cut: 4" square of both leaf fabrics, plus 2 of the light tan fabrics.

Also cut 2 1/4" square to sew in opposite corners as shown in diagram.

Sew block together as shown. The light triangles in the darker leaf squares will complete the tessellation when added to other blocks.

Aren't you glad you don't have to rake these leaves?

Make one or more blocks. Print your name and address on a slip of paper and attach it to the back of each block. Bring as many versions of the block to the **November** meeting as you want. Your name will be entered in the monthly drawing.
