

Block of the Month for the AUGUST 2006 MEETING

Zig Zag 8" block (8-1/2" unfinished)

The drawing for these blocks will take place at the Saturday meeting in August.

Please use 100% cotton fabrics. PLEASE PREWASH THE FABRIC. Note: when making a Block of the Month, please read the instructions carefully, particularly regarding the fabric choices. The pictures may not always be representative of the fabric selection.

FABRIC: Background - white-on-white print (NOT white-on-muslin)

Rectangles - use FOUR DIFFERENT PRINTS, your choice (check your scraps)

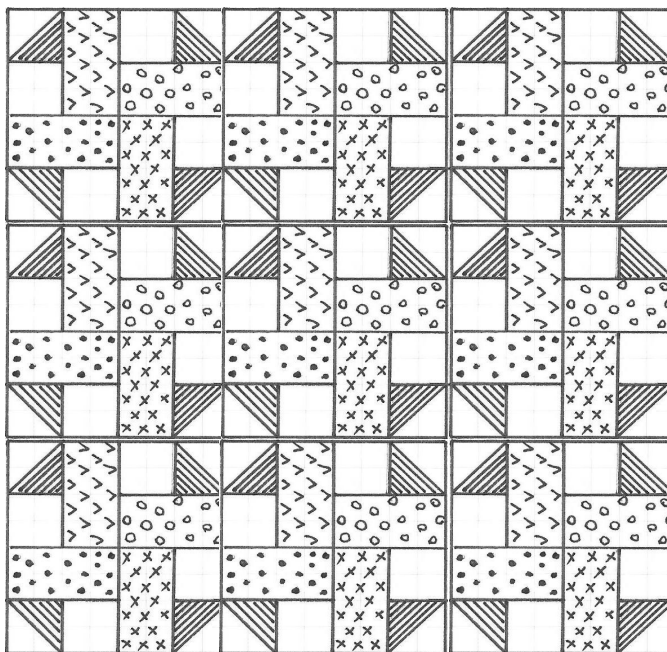
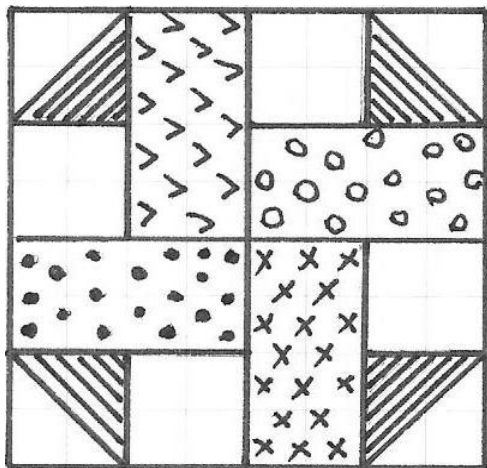
Triangles - use a BLACK tone-on-tone print

CUT: 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares of background

1 - of each print for rectangles, 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Triangles squares are cut from 2 1/2" strips of BOTH background and black fabrics. With right sides facing, and using the EASY ANGLE cutting tool, cut four sets.

Sew block together as shown, but don't sew pieces together with a zig-zag stitch!



Make one or more blocks. Print your name and address on a slip of paper and attach it to the back of each block. Bring as many versions of the block to the August meeting as you like.
