# Whirligig

10" Block (10 1/2" unfinished)

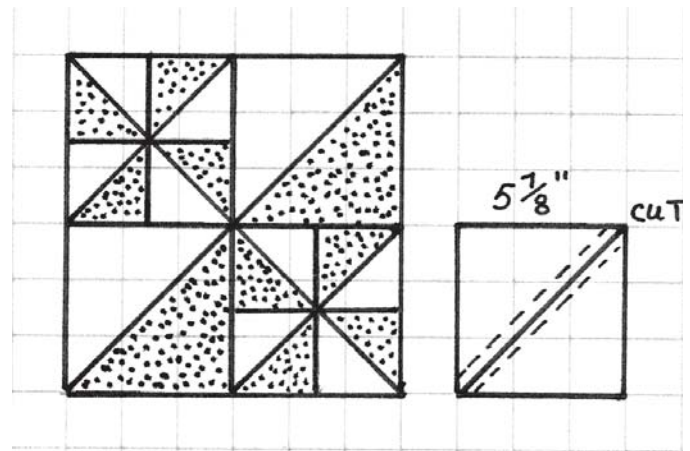
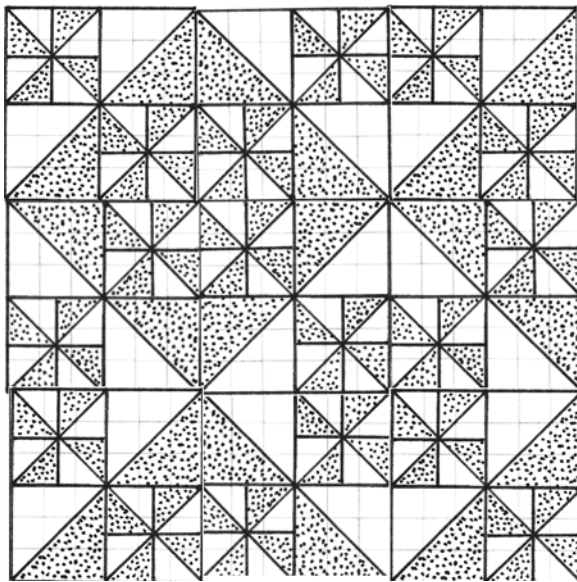
Please use 100% cotton fabrics. PLEASE PREWASH THE FABRIC. Note: When making a Block of the Month, please read the instructions carefully, particularly regarding the fabric choices. The pictures may not always be representative of the fabric selection.

Fabric - Cream print tone on tone  
Print of your choice

Small triangles are cut from 3" strips of each fabric, using the EASY ANGLE cutting tool. For large triangle squares, cut one 5 7/8" square of each fabric. Place right sides together and sew as shown on diagram, then cut apart and press. Sew block together as shown.

Make one or more blocks. Print your name and address on a slip of paper and attach it to the back of each block. Bring as many versions of the block to the March meeting as you want. Your name will be entered in the monthly drawing. If you are unable to attend the meeting, you may send your name and block(s) to:
