

Wedgeworks I - Spinners

In this class we will learn the techniques for working with wedges and how to set a circular design into a square for a quilt block or wall hanging. You may select from seven different variations to make your individual spinners
A very exciting and EASY class!!
Fabric will be cut in class

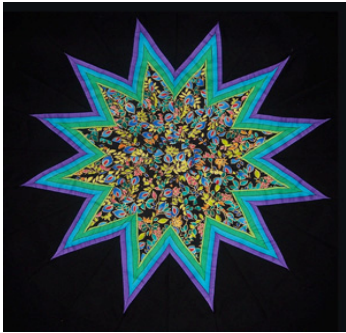
Yardage:

Each spinner will require the following:

1/2 yard background fabric

1/2 yard of spinner fabric

These fabrics should have strong contrasts in value.



Supply List

<u>X</u>	Wedgeworks I Book (includes tool)
<u>X</u>	sewing machine in good working order with manual
<u>X</u>	thread to match - grey of neutral work well for quilt piecing.
<u>X</u>	bobbins pre-wound with the above thread
<u>X</u>	extra machine needles
<u>X</u>	batting to match quilt size
<u>X</u>	rotary cutter
<u>X</u>	rotary mat
<u>X</u>	acrylic ruler - 24" length is best
<u>X</u>	fabric scissors
<u>X</u>	seam ripper (for un-sewing!)
<u>X</u>	1/4" foot if available
