

217AC: Machine Applique the Easy Way

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Please read all instructions below and from the [Basic Sewing List](#) on web site for this workshop before you purchase fabric or make any decisions. Everything you need is available on my website. Please take the time to read and familiarize yourself with the material.

Create the machine appliqué project of your choice; wall hanging, garment, sweatshirt jacket, table runner or pillow using your collection of motif fabrics. [Link to Cluster picture: Machine Applique The Easy Way](#)

Embellishment techniques will be demonstrated for art quilts or wearables. This information is not in your hand out but is available in "Creative Techniques for Wearables", which will be available for purchase; or you are welcome to take notes and pictures of these techniques.

I suggest you keep this project small so that you have time to do embellishment stitching.



Supply List:

For wall hanging: 24" square of solid fabric.

Table runner: 25"x40" or longer if you want extra long table runner. Check the length of your table.

Pillow: 18"x18"

Black is always a good background selection, any color that is a good contrast to your motif fabric.

For wearable:

Purchase pattern for vest, jacket or coat. Purchase background fabric for this pattern, amount the pattern calls for. **Ahead of time:** cut out main pattern pieces, fronts and back, from background fabric, be sure of sizing, and fit before class.

Fabrics:

Selection of distinctive motif fabrics, scaled medium to large, I suggest clear crisp colors. Types of fabric to consider, holiday, foliage, florals, animals, birds, butterflies, ethnic and more.

- 2 yds. fusible web
- # 8 pearl cotton to compliment project
- Bring a selection of rayon and metallic threads to compliment floral and foliage fabrics.
- Extra bobbins
- 15" square of prequilted black fabric, or sandwich of black fabric and batting
- 1 yd. Water soluble Stabilizer see BSL # 36B

Ahead of time: Because of the time it takes to select and prepare motifs; press fusible web on the back of selected motifs and carefully cut out the motifs ahead of time. Do not remove paper backing of web until you come to class. When cutting, trim close to the edge of motif design. Please include any groupings, such as flowers and leaves.
