

Butterfly in the Round

This stunning butterfly is easy to make - only requires 3 fabrics, and can be completed in a half-day class. Learn to do these and make your own "butterfly garden"! Finished quilt 18" Circular wall hanging



YARDAGE

(Note: Yardage is based on 42" wide fabric)

Background - 1/2 yard

Accent on edges of butterfly wings - 1/8 yard

Butterfly wings - 5/8 yard

Body 3" x 3" or scraps

Backing - 5/8 yard

Binding 1/4 yard

CUTTING - Please cut these strips before class:

Background:	One strip	4" x WOF (width of fabric)
	One strip	2 1/2" x WOF
	Two strips	8 1/2" x 10"

Accent:	Two Strips	3/4" x WOF
	(Save your scraps)	

Butterfly wings:	One Strip	8 1/2" x WOF
	One Strip	7 1/2" x WOF

Supply List

Butterfly in the Round Pattern (Includes Tool) available In class

sewing machine in good working order with manual

thread to match - grey or neutral work well for quilt piecing.

bobbins pre-wound with the above thread

extra machine needles

Batting (I suggest and will have Temtex available for a round wallhanging)

rotary cutter

rotary mat

acrylic ruler - 24" length is best

glass head pins

fabric scissors

seam ripper (for un-sewing!)

1/4" foot
