

# 311DM: Perfect and Easy Applique – Carrot Top

Learn to hand or machine applique using the starch method of turning under edges. If you are new to applique or simply want to learn a new technique, this is the class for you. It's fun, easy, and you will be amazed with the results. We will be making the "Carrot Top" quilt from Critter Caboodle by Brandywine Design.

### Supplies:

- *CRITTER CABOODLE* book by Brandywine Design
- Fabric; washed and ironed
- Heat-resistant template plastic (recommended: "Perfect Shape" or "Templar")
- Scissors; one for paper and one for fabric
- Small jar
- Small inexpensive paintbrush
- Pencil and THIN permanent marker (.005 Micron found in most quilt shops)
- Small iron or craft iron (Hobbico sealing irons work great!)
- Roxanne's Glue-Baste-It
- Table-top ironing surface if you have one (some will be provided)
- Applique needle
- Thread to match fabric
- Sewing machine and invisible nylon thread (only if you want to machine applique)
