

317DA: Kaleidoscope Stars

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Please read all instructions below and from the Basic Sewing List for this workshop before you purchase fabric or make any decisions. Everything you need is available on this sight, please take the time to read and familiarize yourself with the material.

In this class you will learn to:

- select and manipulate fabrics to make kaleidoscope star blocks; discovering dynamic use of fabric, color, quick piecing and design.
- make a kaleidoscope pie, one that combines, lines and angles, fabrics and thread.
- Embellishment techniques will be demonstrated for art quilts or wearables. This information is not in your hand out but is available in "Creative Techniques for Wearables", which will be available for purchase; or you are welcome to take notes and pictures of these techniques.



Fabrics

- BSS # 37 http://www.jennyraymond.com/html/supply/basic_supply.htm
- 1 yd. Medium to large print. See Fabric for Fussy Cutting
- **BSS # 40** Be sure and note pictures of fabric types. Bring all types if possible.
- 1 yd. background fabric - see Background fabric **BSS # 39**
- At least 6-8 (this is a minimum) different coordinating Fabrics - (at least) 1/2 yd. each.
- If you have fabric in your stash that could work, bring it along, the more selections the better, this way you will have lots of fabrics to play with.
- Bi-fold mirrors - Bring at least 6"x6" if possible. Purchased two mirror tiles from a home improvement center, use masking tape on the edge to prevent cuts. Next use duck tape to form a Bi-fold.

Template plastic: (# 7 below in BSS) Do not use template plastic with grid, as it is hard to see your fabric design. Ex-ray film is hard to see through and very slippery, I don't suggest it's use. I suggest the EZ brand of template plastic as it's easy to see through and you can write on it.
