

# 403DH: Fine Feathered Friends

## SUPPLIES

- Add-A- Quarter ruler-6 inch and 12 inch size.
- Regular Scotch tape
- Glue stick
- Paper scissors and small scissors with sharp points
- Fabric for your project-see below
- Sewing thread- medium values of your colors
- A couple of extra bobbins for your machine
- Sewing machine-cleaned and oiled. Does not need to zig-zag.
- A quarter inch foot for your machine and an open toed embroidery foot—(only if you already have one).
- Cutting mat- at least 16" X 11" and a rotary cutter with a good blade.
- Rotary ruler-12" size.
- Straight pins
- Supply fee (foundation paper patterns) \$5.00 payable in class.



## FABRIC

There are sixteen different "star" fabrics plus a background fabric in the original version, because each Snowflake/Star is different. If you wish to simplify, you can use the same four fabrics for all four of your stars. For ease in purchasing or working with your stash, I have grouped them as they are used. However, you certainly don't have to abide by my color choices. Variety is the spice! Not: the yardage requirements are exact, no leeway, so you may want to purchase a little extra—only you know how you feel about that!

Fabrics #1 through #4---You need 1/3 of a yard EACH of four different pale blue fabrics, which are used for the light half of the star points and feathers and the strip-pieced border.

Fabric #5 through #8---You need 1/3 of a yard EACH of four different medium blue fabrics which are used for the dark half of star points and feathers and the strip-pieced border.

Fabric #9 through #12—You need ¼ of a yard EACH of four different pale turquoise fabrics, which are used for the lighter half of the Star Tips and the strip-pieced border.

Fabric #13 through #16--- You need ¼ of a yard EACH of four different medium turquoise fabrics, which are used for the darker half of the Star Tips and the strip-pieced border.

BACKGROUND FABRIC #17-You will need 2 ¾ yards of a very dark navy for the backgrounds of the feathers, stars and for the outer border. If you would like to do a contrasting outer border, you will need 1 ½ yards.

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**\*\*\*\*\*PLEASE COME TO CLASS WITH ALL OF YOUR STRIPS CUT AND SUBCUT. CUTTING DIRECTIONS ARE BELOW:**

**From each pale blue and medium blue fabric cut:**

1. Two 2 ½" strips, two 2" strips (for the border) and one 3" strip. Cut the 3" strip into 3" squares (14) and cross-cut to make 28 triangles. Don't sub-cut the rest.
2. From each pale and medium turquoise fabric cut two 2 ½" wide strips. Sub-cut them into 7 ½" pieces. (8 pieces from each fabric). Also from these fabrics cut two 2" strips for the border.
3. From the background fabric cut TWO--- 4 ½ strips LENGTHWISE OF THE FABRIC. Put aside for the outer border. Cut the remaining fabric as follows: Cut five--3" strips. Cut these strips into 3" squares and crosscut diagonally once to make 96 triangles. Also from this fabric, cut six 6" strips. Cut these strips into 6" squares and crosscut diagonally, once, to make 64 triangles.
