

# Radiant Suns Supply List

## Supplies:

- This class is about color and gradations. The more fabric choices you have, the more interesting your quilt will be. Tone-on-tone patterned fabrics are the best choices. There are 3 color-sets of blocks: yellow-red (suns), pink-purple (background) and blue-green (background). **Pick one color-way set to work on in class and bring a minimum of 4-5 (or more if you want a more interesting quilt) fat quarters of each color in your chosen set for a total of 20-25+ fabrics. Choose one of the following sets:**

**Set 1:** 5+ yellows, 5+ yellow-oranges, 5+ oranges, 5+ red-oranges and 5+ red-dark reds.

**Set 2:** 5+ pinks, 5+ dark pinks, 5+ red-purples, 5+ blue-purples and 5+ dark purples.

**Set 3:** 5+ blues, 5+ blue-greens, 5+ dark greens, 5+ yellow-greens and 5+ dark yellow-greens.

Keep in mind that you will be using templates of different sizes and you will use more of some fabrics than others.



- Template plastic, permanent marking pen for plastic and scissors for plastic **OR** purchased Radiant Suns templates. Templates will be available for sale at the workshop for \$26.00, tax included.
- Masking tape.
- Rotary cutters, sizes 45 and 28 with a mat.
- Thread to match fabrics or a neutral color.
- Pins, just in case.
- Sewing machine with extension table and quarter inch foot if you have one. A knee-lift is also very helpful but not required.
- Iron and ironing board if you need to press fabrics.
- Radiant Sun pattern which is provided in the workshop.
- Design wall. This is helpful to see your blocks and doesn't need to be big.

Optional : 12 1/2" Square see-through ruler for squaring up the blocks. It's optional because you won't need it unless you just want to make a few blocks in class.

I will be doing a demonstration on free motion quilting and binding by machine. If you would like to try this out in class, please add the following to your supplies:

- 18" X 22" or fat quarter sized quilt sandwich with 100% cotton batting inside. No need to baste this.
- 2 1/2" X width of fabric (40"+) for binding.
- Darning foot for your machine.
- Zipper foot for your machine.

Bring a notebook or a magazine. This is to store your pieces for your blocks so they stay smooth and right side up. You'll love this trick!
