

417DA: Stars that Snap Crackle Pop

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Please read all instructions below and from the Basic Sewing List for this workshop before you purchase fabric or make any decisions. Everything you need is available on this sight, please take the time to read and familiarize yourself with the material.

This is a **Design** class to learn how to select and manipulate fabrics to make spectacular star blocks. discovering dynamic use of fabric, color and design.

Embellishment techniques will be demonstrated for art quilts or wearables. This information is not in your hand out but is available in "Creative Techniques for Wearables", which will be available for purchase; or you are welcome to take notes and pictures of these techniques.

Class Projects: You will have the choice of three different Project Selections: jacket made on a sweatshirt, jacket made from commercial pattern and wallhanging.

Due to the Time Limitations of Class, we will work on Designing your blocks, you can decide on the exact project later.

Give yourself lots of choices. Fat Quarters are great.

2yd. medium to large print (BSS # 40) Be sure to note pictures of fabric types. Bring all types if possible. http://www.jennyraymond.com/html/supply/basic_supply.htm

2 yd. background fabric (BSS # 39)

At least 7 different coordinating Fabrics - 1/2 yd. each. (Minimum number)

If you have fabric in your stash that could work, bring it along, the more selections the better.

12" square of prequilted black fabric, or sandwich of black fabric and batting.



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Template plastic: (# 7 below in BSS) Do not use template plastic with grid, as it is hard to see your fabric design. Ex-ray film is hard to see through and very slippery, I don't suggest it's use. I suggest the EZ brand of template plastic as it's easy to see through and you can write on it.
