

F01A Strips and Stripes

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Supplies

Sewing machine, thread, needles, pins scissors (paper and fabric), seam ripper, ruler such as 6x24 (also 6x12 is helpful), rotary cutter and blades, mat

Cording: 5 yards of 1 mm polyester drapery

BASE: 36 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

4 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

These can be **typing paper** (which will be removed as in paper piecing) or **muslin** which will become part of the table runner.

PRECUT

FABRIC

MAIN ACCENT FABRIC: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Black with a little White. This could be same fabric or could be several similar fabric scraps

SOLID COLORS: Strips are a variety of widths- 1", 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 2", 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (3 yards total of a variety of colors)

PIPING: 4 strips 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42"

BINDING: 4 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"

BATTING: 28" x 75" (to finish at home)

BACKING: 28" x 75" (to finish at home)

Other color suggestions: Main accent red with other fabrics black/white

Main white with other Aunt Grace fabrics

Main Black with other oriental fabrics
