

# **F05P Fabric Origami**

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## **Supplies Needed**

Sample Quilt is 30" x 30". for a quilt that size you will need the following fabrics:

- ¼ yard each of 16 different floral fabrics for the folded 'flowers'  
(Regular or fat quarters will work, and you may repeat some of the fabrics, in which case you would need fewer than sixteen.)
- 1 ¼ yards of background fabric (light or dark, solid or tone-on-tone)
- 1 ¼ yards of a solid or print fabric for the sashing, borders, and binding
- 1 yard fabric for quilt backing
- ¼ yard Wonder-Under or similar product

Sewing machine, extra needles, pins, scissors  
Thread to match fabrics, filled bobbins  
Rotary mat, cutter, ruler, spray bottle, press cloth, extension cord  
Task light, if desired  
Fabric glue (If you have it. You don't need much, so we can share.)

## **Pre-Class Cutting Instructions**

It is a good idea to pre-wash your fabrics so you won't have fading or shrinkage problems later.

From the assorted prints cut:

- 16 squares 8" x 8"
- 16 squares 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"
- 16 squares 1 ½" x 1 ½"

From the background fabric cut:

- 16 squares 6" x 6"
- 32 squares 4 ½" x 4 ½"

From the border fabric cut the following strips **parallel** to the salvages:

- 4 strips 4" wide by the length of the fabric (for the outer border)
- 4 strips 1 ½" wide by the length of the fabric (for the sashing)
- 3 strips 2" wide by the length of the fabric (for the binding)

(if you aren't sure about these cutting instructions, you may wait and cut the border fabric during class.)
