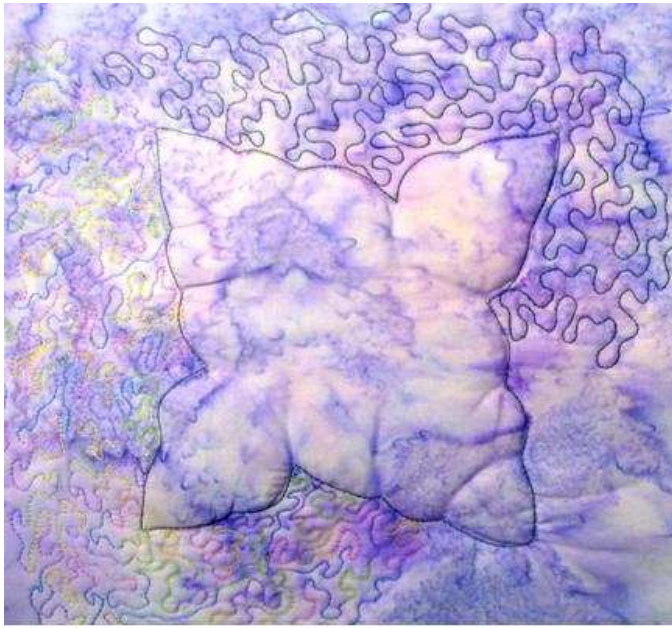
Your kit will include the following:

- Muslin quilt sandwiches to practice your machine quilting skills

Please bring the following supplies:

- blue washout quilter’s marking pens – 2 or 3 new ones
- safety pins for basting – one dozen
- basic sewing supplies (scissors, stitch ripper, etc.).
- cushion for your chair so you will be at a better height for machine quilting.
- threads:
 - blue 50 weight cotton – any shade of blue
 - cream 50 weight cotton
 - invisible nylon or polyester – YLI, Sulky or Superior Monopoly recommended
 - rayon or trilobal polyester – Sulky, Mettler or Superior Rainbows recommended
- sewing machine needles:
 - Universal or Jeans #80
 - Quilting #75
 - Topstitch #90
 - Metallic #80
- notepad and pen for making notes.
- **If sewing machines are not supplied in the classroom**, please bring your sewing machine – bring all attachments & feet and your instruction manual. You will need a darning foot (may be called a free motion quilting foot or an embroidery foot). You will also need to drop or cover your feed dogs. Check with your machine dealer if necessary.
