

F12D Give and Take Applique with Susan Purney-Mark

You can use a variety of different fabrics in this project, think of hand dyes, batiks and mottled type designs. Small or medium scale prints work well. Look at having good contrast between light and dark fabrics.

Kit Fee: \$12 to be paid to teacher at beginning of class.

Fabric:

- two light and one dark fat quarters for practice-can be anything but try for close to solid colour or small scale print
- 2 yards light fabric and 1 yard dark fabric. Try for good contrast between the two fabrics.

You will be completing several simple design exercises in the morning with paper, scissors, design mirrors and glue and then having the opportunity to use those designs in the afternoon.

Other Supplies:

- Fusible web (I strongly recommend Steam a Seam 2) bring 2 yards of 12" width
- Pencil, paper scissors and school-type ruler
- Rotary cutting equipment
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Sewing machine in good working order , must be capable of doing a zig zag stitch
- Paper and pencil for note taking
- Suitable thread for piecing
- Thread that will match your chosen dark fabric for the top stitching (if black fabric then bring black thread etc.)
