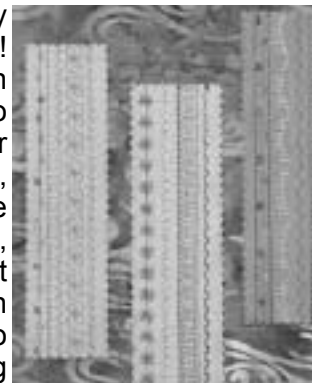

F01P: Flying Geese in a Brave New World

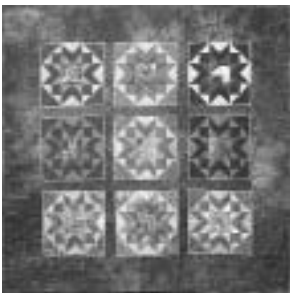
