

T09D: Basket Case

You'll be amazed at the clever and easy way these baskets are pieced! Once your baskets are made, you'll learn some fun techniques for filling the baskets. The setting is traditional '30s style, on point. There will be YOYO flowers, fused appliqué flowers, traditional appliqué and other ideas. You can use some of all of the techniques. The quilt is cute even with empty baskets! It's a queen size quilt but would also make a nice wall hanging.

Supplies:

Basket Case pattern

Background – 2 ¼ yards white tone on tone fabric, use an assortment or just one print

Basket handles – ¼ yard or use an assortment of 1" strips if you want a scrappy look

Baskets – ½ yard EACH of 3 or 4 fabrics

Setting squares – 1 yard (can be the same as background)

Sashing and binding – 1 ½ yards

For the flowers:

We will talk about 3 different styles of appliqué and each will be demonstrated in class

If you would like to do fusible appliqué in the broderie perse style get 1 yard of a medium size floral that has flowers that will be easy to cut out

You can bring assorted fabrics for regular needle turn or fused appliqué

OR

Assorted scraps (6" squares will work) for yoyo flowers. The pattern will need about ¼ yard of green fabric for leaves that go with the yoyo flowers.

We will also be using the Clover brand Yoyo maker in the Extra small, small and large sizes if you wish to use them for your flowers.
