

T13D Focus on Fabric

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Discover a new way to work with yukatas, batiks and other large scale figurative prints. Let the fabric tell you how to use it! Traditional piecing and simple applique come together to create a one-of-a-kind art quilt. Full day. All levels

Supplies:

½ -1 yard focus fabric – should contain approximately six design motifs, or one major and several minor motifs.

1 yard each of several colors – textured prints, marbled, hand dyed, batik or other fabric for background and borders.

Threads for piecing background fabrics and for applique of focus fabric.

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler.

Sewing machine.

Fabric marking pencil.

Small scissors.

Applique needles.

Other basic sewing supplies.

Graph paper

Freezer paper
