

# T15D: Hand Quilting Is FUN

We'll get down to the basics of hand quilting with a no nonsense approach to a great quilt stitch. This is a fun class where you learn that it does not take special equipment or tools to get the desired result. You'll be shown several techniques for preparing your quilt, including, transferring your designs on to the fabric surface and basting the layers together. Emphasis will be on making an **even quilting stitch** with the proper selection of needles, thread and fabric. Bring your imagination and your desire to learn or improve your hand quilting results. We're going to have fun making beautiful designs with a needle. BUT WAIT!! As an added bonus, my husband George Siciliano, maker of "those" incredible miniature quilts, will assist me in this class. He promised to bring several of his minis so you can get a real close look and also likes to tell funny stories. You're definitely going to have a good time.

**Supply List:** Thimble, 14" Hoop (or we'll loan you one), portable light source (if possible), 'Prismacolor' white pencil and blue washable fine-line pen (for quilters).

**Kit Fee- \$10.00 includes** 1 ½ yards of fabric, ¾ yard of batting. Needles and thread for basting and quilting, loaner hoops (if needed), pins, marking pencils and a booklet to take notes if you wish.
