Shattered Circles

Elegant, exciting results from an easy to master technique. We'll start with a simple circle and dissect and separate it into seemingly unrelated pieces, then reassemble to create something new and different. You may choose to complete one small quilt during class, or leave your sewing machine at home and spent the day designing and laying out several small quilts.

Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Supply List:

Option 1: Bring sewing machine and basic sewing supplies to complete one quilt

- *Fabric scissors
- *Paper scissors
- *Pencil and eraser
- *1 yard fabric for background
- *Fat quarter for circle
- *Batting, backing and binding
- *½ yard fusible web (Wonder Under or Tans-Web preferred)
- *Size 90 Topstitch needle
- *Decorative threads and basic sewing thread in appropriate colors

Option 2: Leave sewing machine at home and design several small quilts

- *Fabric scissors
- *Paper scissors
- *Pencil and eraser
- *1 yard fabric for background for each quilt
- *Fat Quarter for circle for each quilt
- *½ yard fusible web (Wonder Under, Trans-Web) for each quilt
