

W07D Too Easy Stained Glass

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Stained glass with no bias, no glue – it's just fast and fun! You will learn a quick way to make a stunning wallhanging with a printed scene fabric and fusible web. This great reverse appliqué method has lots of possibilities!

Your kit will include the following:

- **Fat quarter of scene fabric and an accent fabric**
- **Fusible web**
- **Black thread**

Please bring the following supplies:

Fabric:

- Black solid 100% cotton (for stained glass leading) 1 yard
(choose a good quality fabric – one that is not too thin)

Supplies:

- 15" x 18" piece low loft cotton or cotton/poly batting (you **WILL** need this for class)
- 12-15 safety pins for basting
- Sewing machine with ¼" patchwork foot and wide foot for zigzag stitching (open toe foot if you have one)
- Rotary cutting equipment: rotary cutter, 6" x 24" ruler, 18" x 24" cutting mat
- Basic sewing supplies (pins, seam ripper, medium size fabric scissors, hand sewing needles)
- Sharp pencil and school-type ruler for tracing
- *Optional:* art knife (Olfa makes one that is excellent)
