

W12D Dragon Bones and Fish Fingers

In this class you will have the opportunity to learn a great technique that has many different design options. You will be able to choose from a variety of shapes, including a square, rectangle, diamond or triangle. You will then plan a placement of insertion strips using a couple of different techniques. The resulting work can range from totally abstract through to a more realistic design. Lots of choices along the way mean surprises and fun!

Fabric

You will need 2-3 yards of medium to dark fabric. If possible, bring several to choose from, look for a variety of colours, batiks, work very well. Hand dyes are good or fabrics which change colour/pattern/value across the width and/or length. Florals are a possibility as are textures and hand dyes.

¼ yard each of several (at least 4) fabrics which contrast strongly with the above fabrics

(you can also go the opposite way and have light coloured background with a variety of dark contrasting fabrics)

Equipment

Rotary cutting equipment, 6"x24" ruler, mat and cutter
Neutral piecing thread
Sewing machine in good working order
Basic Sewing Supplies, including straight pins with ball heads
Paper and Pencil for notes
1 sheet template plastic
