Crazy Beading



Taught by Nancy Eha

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Learn to replicate traditional Crazy Quilt needlework embroidery stitches with seed beads. Coined "Crazy Beading" by Nancy. Then explore embellishment options including petals and grapes. Beaded edging variations will also be covered. Techniques taught are great for quilts, art quilts, and crazy quilts. **1 day workshop**, sampler class, all experience levels, no sewing machines needed

\$13 mandatory materials fee includes: thread, needles, beads, directions, etc.

Supply List

Students should bring to workshop:

Fabric: Crazy Quilt Block

Construct a 10 or 12 inch Crazy Quilt block onto a muslin base.

Segments should be rather large, as beading takes up more space than floss, etc. Segments should be no smaller than 5" x 3"

Use solid fabrics or tone on tone for most segments. Use patterned fabric sparingly. You can construct the block with cottons or fancy fabric.

Optional CQ Block (see above) **OR** a 12" square of muslin, or cotton to bead on as a sampler.

A few straight pins

Small sharp scissors or embroidery scissors

Paper scissors

Cool Whip size lid, white non-segmented small white glass or ceramic plate to bead off of, or Velux beading cloth

Glasses if needed for handwork

Lamp with extension cord

Power strip to share
