Learn easy paper foundation piecing to make the curved flying geese. Then learn to piece the curved seams to finish the block. I will provide papers to make two blocks in class and then I will talk about many different ways to set your blocks to make some striking quilts. 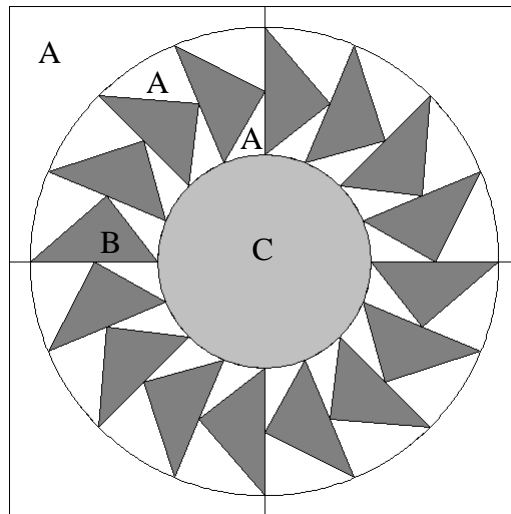
Supplies

Sewing Machine
Rotary Equipment
General Sewing Supplies
Add-A-Quarter Ruler
Double Sided Scotch Tape – in the yellow package
Fabric Scissors
Paper Scissors
Fabric Glue Stick
Freezer Paper – 12” X 18”
Nylon Monofilament Thread .004
Open Toe Appliqué Foot
Tweezers

Fabric:

2 - 12” Blocks

A -Background Fabric: ½ yd
B - Geese Fabric: ¼ yd
C - Center Circle Fabric: ¼ yd



Cutting Before Class:

Background Fabric – Cut 2 – 2 ¾” strips,
cut these into 32 – 2 ¾” X 1 ½” rectangles

Cut 2 – 3 ¼” strips, cut these into 32 – 3 ¼” X 2” rectangles

Geese Fabric - Cut 2 – 4” strips, cut these into 32 - 4” X 2 ¼” rectangles

Bring your leftover fabric with you for the frame around the geese and in case you make a mistake and have to cut more rectangles.
