

## Stacked 4-Patch in a BQ Setting



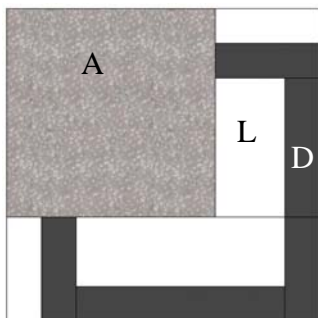
- Sewing Machine
- Rotary Equipment
- General Sewing Supplies
- Neutral Colored Pearl Cotton – this is used when stacking the fabric
- Chenille Needle that the Pearl Cotton will fit into
- BQ Pattern

### **Fabric:**

Focus Fabric – you will need four repeats of this fabric. I measure the repeat size, multiply by 4 and add a couple of inches for good measure. The focus fabric needs to be a medium to large print that has good contrast. Look for something with a variety of shapes, lines and colors. There should also be some background showing, not just solid flowers or shapes. The number of blocks you are able to make from the fabric will depend on the size of the fabric repeat. If you have a small repeat and want to make a large quilt you may need to buy eight repeats. With a 12” repeat I was able to make 36 stacked blocks and used 35 in my quilt. It measures approximately 56” X 78” without borders.

Background fabric and sashing - The amounts you need for this will depend on the size of quilt that you are making.

BQ – 9” blocks – I added sashing between my blocks for this setting, they needed space to breathe.



For every 6 blocks you will need –

A - Stacked 4-Patch from Focus which we will do in class

L - 6 ½” for background plus ½ yard for sashing

D – 6”

Borders - optional
