

Slow and Steady Turtle **Cathy Miller**

A very classy looking turtle, made with fabric scraps and hand appliqué. Students will learn freezer paper appliqué using **three techniques** and the best situations for each. This charming turtle pattern will be ready to finish in the car or in front of the fire at home – a perfect hand work project to carry anywhere!

Hand appliqué suitable for beginners - 3 hour class.

Pattern purchase required (\$5.00).

SUPPLY LIST:

- three different 8" squares of fabric for turtle's spots
- one 9x11" piece of dark fabric for turtle's back
- one 9" square of turtle's limbs fabric (a woodgrain with small knots is recommended)
- one fat quarter of background fabric
- one 10x11" square of freezer paper
- pins
- hand sewing needles
- fabric scissors AND paper scissors
- thread to match the fabric (gradations of grey are recommended)
