## Quilting in the Quarry

Projects made in this class will all be unique. This technique lends itself to huge variations according to the preferences of the creator. Please visit Gallery - Fabric Collages on my website ([www.janettricefiberart.com](http://www.janettricefiberart.com)) to see a few examples of collages.



- Sewing machine and normal sewing supplies - all in good working order (needles, pins, scissors, etc.)
- Cutting tools (cutter, ruler, mat, etc)
- Light weight fusible interfacing - about  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard
- Peltex or Timtex - about  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard (Be sure to note if it is fusible on one, both or no sides. I prefer the fusible on both sides but fusible is not essential)
- Steam-A-Seam, Misty Fuse or other fusible film if you do not get fusible Peltex or Timtex (See above note)
- Batting - about  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard (cotton is best)
- Fabric scraps in the color scheme of your choice - at least 10 different colors but more is better
- Backing fabric - about  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard
- Yarns, threads, buttons, beads, etc for embellishment purposes
- Sewing threads in coordinating colors
- Glue stick or other fabric glue
- Parchment paper or other material for protection when fusing

### OPTIONAL SUPPLIES

- Nylon netting or tulle - about  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard in color to coordinate with fabric
- Reducing glass
- Color wheel - optional, but comes in handy when deciding on colors
